The following guidelines outline the nomination process.

1. Nominators must be an Agricultural Bureau Branch secretary.
2. More than one nominee may be presented with this Award.
3. Nominees must be involved in primary production in South Australia and agree to being nominated.
4. Nominees should have a considerable or extensive background in primary production. The award is intended to recognise those whose contribution to primary production has been significant over a period of time.
5. Nominators must give careful consideration to what is considered as primary production.

The Award is not restricted to primary producers, other service industries, government, education, research and agro-politics may be included.

6. Ideally the Award should assist nominees in their endeavours.
For example, by publicising a difficult issue, by recognising that they have been a 'lone and unpopular voice' in spite of their achievements or providing a service that has been of assistance to primary production or has helped to progress the industry.
7. This Award is in recognition of an exemplary service and honours an individual or group at a particular time that exemplifies the aims and objectives of the Agricultural Bureau of South Australia.
8. Other than seeking approval by the nominee, nominations must not be discussed with the nominee, but can however, be discussed with referees.
9. The Agricultural Bureau of South Australia reserves the right to withhold a nominee if the quality of nominees does not warrant the title or if the nominee does not meet the selection criteria.
